



Tribal Council Resolution 2022-14

AUTHORIZATION FOR SIGNATURE AUTHORITY FOR NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE (NRCS) PROGRAMS

Whereas Skagway Village (dba Skagway Traditional Council) is the federally recognized tribal government for all enrolled tribal citizens in Skagway, Alaska; and

Whereas Skagway Traditional Council is responsible for the health, safety, welfare and Cultural preservation of its tribal citizens and use of the Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory; and

Whereas Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory reflects all lands and waters historically and presently occupied and utilized by the Skagway Native people since immemorial, and land within the modern-day community of Skagway as identified in STC Constitutions, Article II Section 1: and

Whereas Article IX Section 3(g) of the Constitution of STC specifically directs the STC Tribal Council "to protect and preserve Tribal property, wildlife, and natural resources of importance to the Tribe:" and

Whereas, to enter into a contract through NRCS, the agency requires acceptance by Skagway Village through an authorized representative of Skagway Village; and

Whereas NRCS requires clear designation of corporation representatives authorized to sign documents and contracts with the NRCS.

Now therefore be it resolved that the elected tribal council members hereby authorize the following, or their immediate successors where applicable, to enter into contract starting in FY23 and until rescinded with NRCS:

(Primary) Tribal Administrator, Sara Kinjo-Hischer
(Alternate) Tribal President, Jaime Bricker
