<b>Term</b> <i>Seasonal (32-40 hrs. a week) May – mid. October + part time (15-30 hrs. a week) the last 2 weeks of April</i>	

### Job Description

This position is at the Skagway Traditional Council 1-acre farm, located at 2-mile Klondike Highway in Skagway Alaska. With primary responsibilities being assisting the farm manager as part of a crew in all aspects of a farm to market operation.

### Duties and Responsibilities

- Performing all tasks needed for a farm to market operation including seeding, transplanting, weeding, watering, fertilizing, hauling soil and amendments, forming beds, harvesting, processing, packaging, & selling.
- Tending to nursery plants, handling money and transactions, customer service.
- Operating equipment including riding mower, weed eater, tiller, and driving work truck.
- Tasks will require lifting, hauling, moving up to 40lb daily as well as kneeling, standing, and performing repetitive tasks for long periods of time. We will be working in all weather, rain, wind, or sun.

The statements above are intended to describe the general nature and level of work performed by a person in this position. They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all duties that may be performed in such a position.

### Qualifications

 Minimum qualifications include:

- Must be able to work independently and with a team.
- Must have good communication skills.
- Must be able to lift and move up to 40lb daily.
- Must be willing to kneel, stand and perform repetitive tasks for hours at a time.
- Interest or experience working on farms, gardens, or horticulture.
- Must be able to work in variable and challenging weather conditions.
